For our Fabric and Fibre Art unit we are focusing on weaving. This term we are excited to be introducing the SHARP reading programme to our guided reading sessions. SHARP reading focuses on developing children's ability to decode words quickly by looking for chunks and syllables in hard words. It ensures children's understanding of the vocabulary and their overall understanding of the message within the text. Children will continue to read with a teacher everyday, however they may not bring a new reading book home each night. At this level we expect children to be reading books of their own choice at home, for example chapter books and library books - see some recommended reads on our team weebly.
